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WFI Book Scholarship Guidelines

Criteria

- Be a graduating female high school senior.
- Letter of acceptance from an accredited college, university or technical institution.
- A 500 – 600 word essay
 - **Topic:** What is your vision of a successful mentoring relationship?
- Two (2) **sealed** letters of recommendation from a principal, teacher, guidance counselor, minister, youth advisor or employer.
- Official School Transcript displaying a Grade Point Average of 2.5 or higher.

Essay Details and Format

Typed

Double Spaced

Time New Roman font (size 12)

One-inch margins on all sides

Title page containing your name, date and the title of the essay

Use black or blue ink (only) when completing the application

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ESSAY ASSESSMENT RUBRIC

TASK: Write an effective persuasive essay, between 500 - 600 words on the following topic:
“What is your vision of a successful mentoring relationship?”

PERFORMANCE CONDITIONS: You must create your own essay. Your final product cannot exceed 600 words, must be double spaced, use 12- point Times New Roman font, and have one-inch margins.

SCORING: Scoring will be based on the Essay Assessment Criteria listed below; the four areas will carry equal weight in the assessment. Your total numerical score will be 0 to 20.
